The project *Urban Space: The Work and Practice of Luc Deleu – T.O.P. office* presents the long awaited in-depth study of the work and practice of Antwerp-based architect and urban planner [Luc Deleu](#) (°1944, Duffel, Belgium). Since 1973, he deals with the 'urbanism', looking for an urban design that is critical, sociological and ecological. In 1980, he writes the 'Orbanistic Manifesto' in which he argues for a global architecture, with a concern for environmental problems like pollution and overpopulation.

Besides a comprehensive publication, there will also be an internationally traveling exhibition (first venue, Stroom Den Haag (NL), March 2012).
